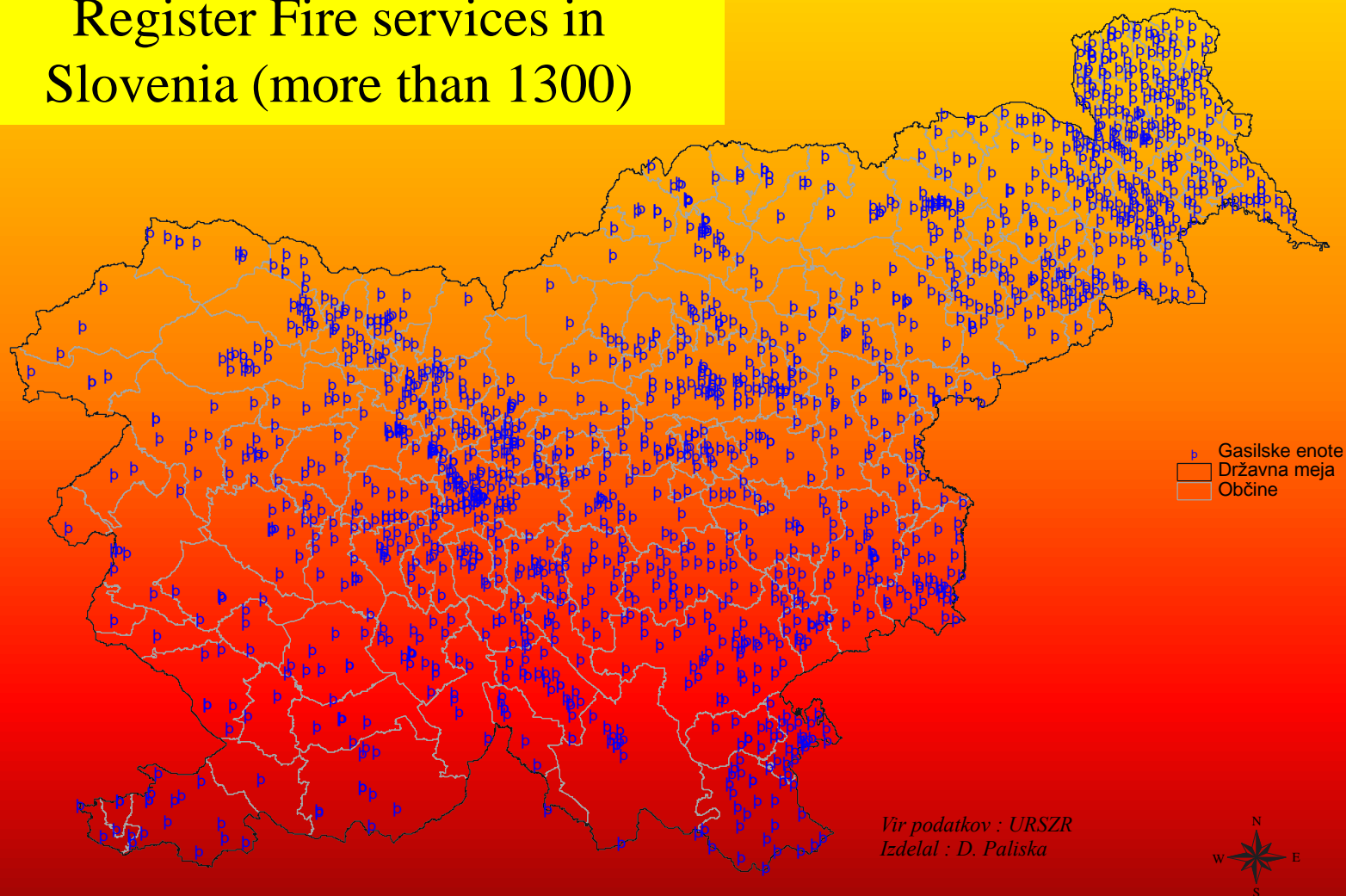

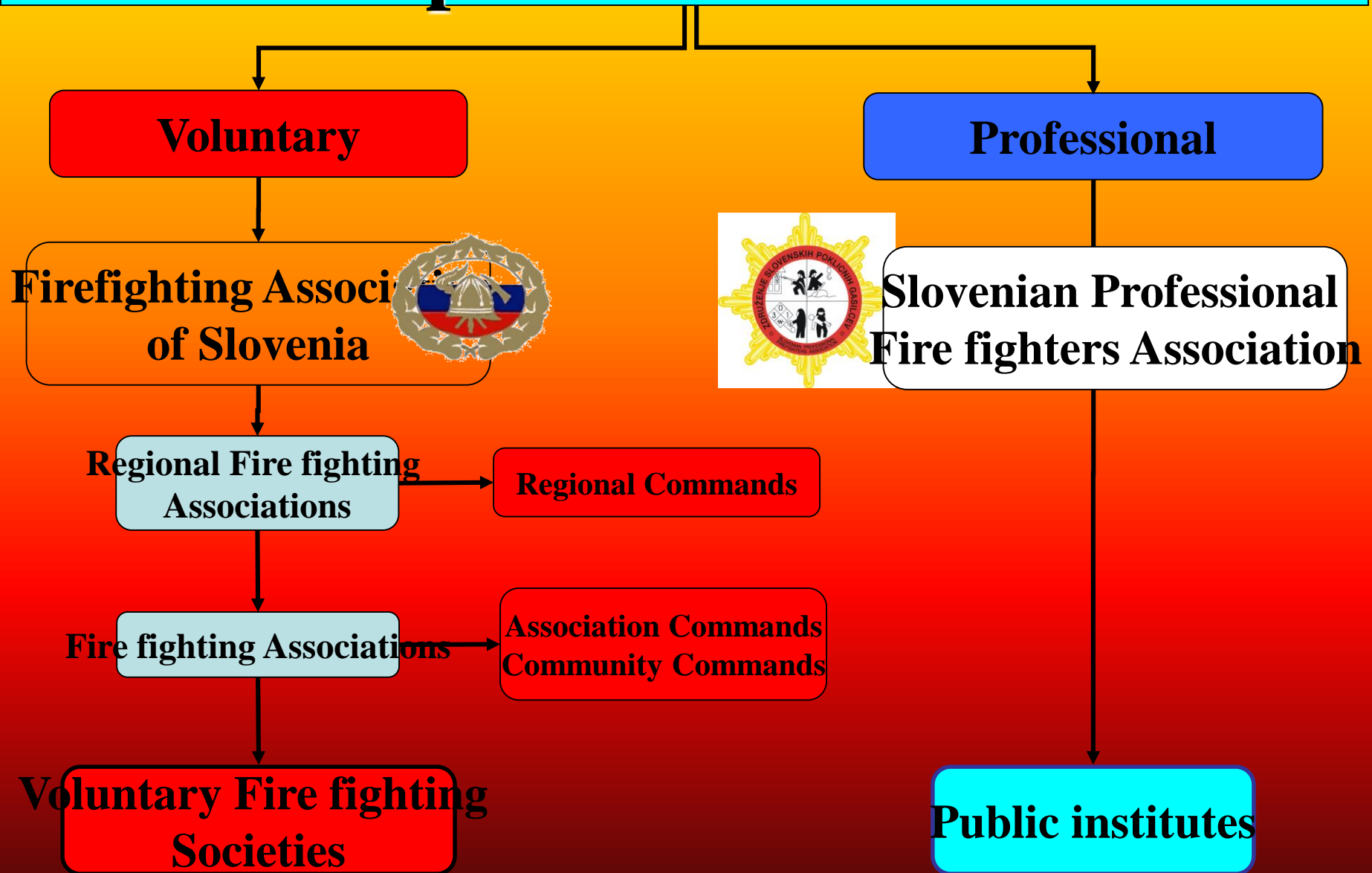

# Fire Fighting System in the Republic of Slovenia



# **Professional Fire fighting**

- United in Slovenian Professional Fire fighters Association
- Approximate 800 professional fire fighters
- Consists of territorial and industrial units
- Rising tendency

# Voluntary Fire fighting

- Tradition of more than 140 years
- Over 1300 voluntary Fire fighting Societies
- Associated in Fire fighting Association of Slovenia
- Fire fighting Societies are categorized with regard to risk in surroundings, expanse of territory, distance of professional fire fighters ...

# Education of Professional Firefighters

- 1. Level: Basic Training 20 weeks – fire fighter
- Complementary Trainings
- 2. Level: Training of Intervention Leaders 8 weeks – fire officer
- 3. Level: Fire engineer (new fire officer training) – pending





# Education of Voluntary Fire fighters

- Basic Training – Fire fighting Associations
- Continuation Training – Fire fighting Association of Slovenia
- Permanent Training – Fire fighting Associations







# RESPONSIBILITY FOR FIRE PROTECTION

- Legal responsibility for fire protection is in domain of local community
- Special purpose units are out of domain of local community
- Special purpose units receive the licence for certain tasks from the state (traffic accidents, HazMat, Tunnels)

# SPECIAL PURPOSE TASKS

- Accidents with hazardous materials
- Traffic accidents
- Intervention in tunnels at fire or other accidents

# SPECIAL PURPOSE UNITS

- At the moment 44 special purpose units
- All professional units included
- Voluntary units – also central units in their local community
- Financing also from Administration for Civil Protection and Disaster Relief
